CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Our Annual General Meeting held last November on the farm could be hailed as a success. The meeting was enjoyable and enlightening. What was encouraging was the contribution of ideas from the floor by owners and unit managers.

It was most appropriate that the issue of rental arrears on the Motiwai block be discussed on the farm rather than at a venue not associated with Te Urunga B2. Following lengthy discussion the meeting passed three resolutions. In brief, the resolutions gave the Incorporation approval to cancel the lease and begin farming the block, the outstanding rent would not have to be paid and when the meeting was over to go to Motiwai for karakia whakawatea because it was said a tapu had been placed on the land.

It was disappointing the whanau of the late Robert Houopapa did not attend the meeting to put to the owners their side of the story. However, a letter was sent telling them what had happened at the AGM and inviting them to meet with the Committee of Management to discuss the "hand over" of the block. The letter concluded by saying that if they hadn't made contact with the COM by the 19 December then the COM would re-enter the property.

On the afternoon of Saturday 19 December the COM, helped by the farm managers, re-entered by putting cows and calves on Motiwai. Immediately members of Robert's family, who were on Motiwai at the time, chased the animals back on to the road.

The COM then asked the managers to take the animals back to the main farm because it did not want to provoke any action that would worsen the situation.

The COM has re-entered Motiwai but has been prevented from occupying the block because Robert's family refuses to allow us to go onto the property.

The COM has now instructed Wallace Bain Law Office to apply to the Maori Land Court under Section 20 of Te Ture Whenua Maori 1993 Act to return Motiwai for direct control by the COM of Te Urunga B2 Incorporation. The Maori Land Court will inform us of the hearing date.

Robert Houopapa's family has been informed of the Incorporation's action.

DIVIDEND PAYMENTS

From 1 January 1996 new laws come into effect in the manner in which cheques are written and accepted on presentation. Cheques made out "Not Transferable" or "Account Payee" mean that:

- The cheque cannot be endorsed or transferred to anyone else. It must be deposited into the bank account of the person for whom it was written.
- Under the new law it is a requirement that the name of the person or business written on the cheque must be the same as their bank account name.

It is this last requirement that causes concern to the COM. Many of you on the Incorporation Share Register have multiple share ownership and names. Our dividend cheques are computer printed off the share register.

Under the new law many of you are not going to be able to deposit your dividend payment cheques as the names on your cheques are not going to be the same as your bank account name. We are aware that owners in the past have had difficulty in depositing or cashing their dividend cheques, but under the new law it will be impossible.

OPTIONS:

You have two options to consider:

1. Direct credit to your bank account. Direct credit forms are enclosed for you to fill in and return.
2. It is possible to establish a separate register for dividend payments only. You would be required to provide your bank account name and your known name, and documentation to the COM that you are one and the same person.

STATEMENT OF INTENT

The project shall have a life of 5 years effective from 1 July 1998 to 30 June 2003.
